WHAT DOES GOD'S WORD SAY ABOUT BAPTISM?

Pastor: In Matthew 28, Jesus commissions His disciples to make disciples by baptizing and teaching. Jesus said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." (Matthew 28:18-19)

St. Paul teaches that we are buried with Christ in Baptism (Colossians 2:12, Romans 6:4). And through the apostle Peter our Lord has given this promise: "Baptism now saves you" (1 Peter 3:21).

The Word of God also tells us why everyone needs to be saved, even infants: For we are conceived and born sinful and are under the power of the devil until Christ claims us as His own (Romans 3:10-19, Jeremiah 17:9). We would be lost forever unless delivered from sin, death, and everlasting condemnation. But the Father of all mercy and grace sent His Son, who atoned for the sins of the whole world, including the sins of young children.

Hear the Gospel according to St. Luke: "Now they were bringing even infants to Him that He might touch them. And when the disciples saw it, they rebuked them. But Jesus called them to Him, saying, 'Let the children come to me, and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God. Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it.'" (Luke 18:15-17)

Pastor: This is the Word of the Lord.

People: **Thanks be to God.**

Pastor: McKayla and Michael, God has entrusted you with the physical and spiritual care of this child. You are to help her grow in the grace and knowledge of her Lord and Savior by reading God's Word to her at home, teaching her the Catechism, bringing her to Sunday School, Confirmation Class, and the Divine Service. Through the power of His Word, God will enable Giuliana to grow up into who she is in Christ. Are you willing to fulfill this task which God has given you to do? If so, then answer, "Yes, with the help of God."

ADDRESS TO THE CONGREGATION

Pastor: Are you, the members of St. Matthew, prepared to accept Giuliana into your church family? Will you show her true Christian love and concern? Will you pray for her this week and throughout her life? And are you willing to assist in her development as a child of God by providing the best in Christian education? If so, then answer, “Yes, with the help of God.”

People: Yes, with the help of God.

Pastor: May our Lord bless each of you – parents, sponsors, and congregation – in this labor of love which He has given you to do.

CONFESSION OF FAITH

Pastor: Do you renounce the devil?

People: Yes, I renounce him.

Pastor: Do you renounce all his works?

People: Yes, I renounce them.

Pastor: Do you renounce all his ways?

People: Yes, I renounce them.

Pastor: Do you believe in God, the Father Almighty?

People: Yes, I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.

Pastor: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son?

People: Yes, I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

Pastor: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit?

People: Yes, I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.


